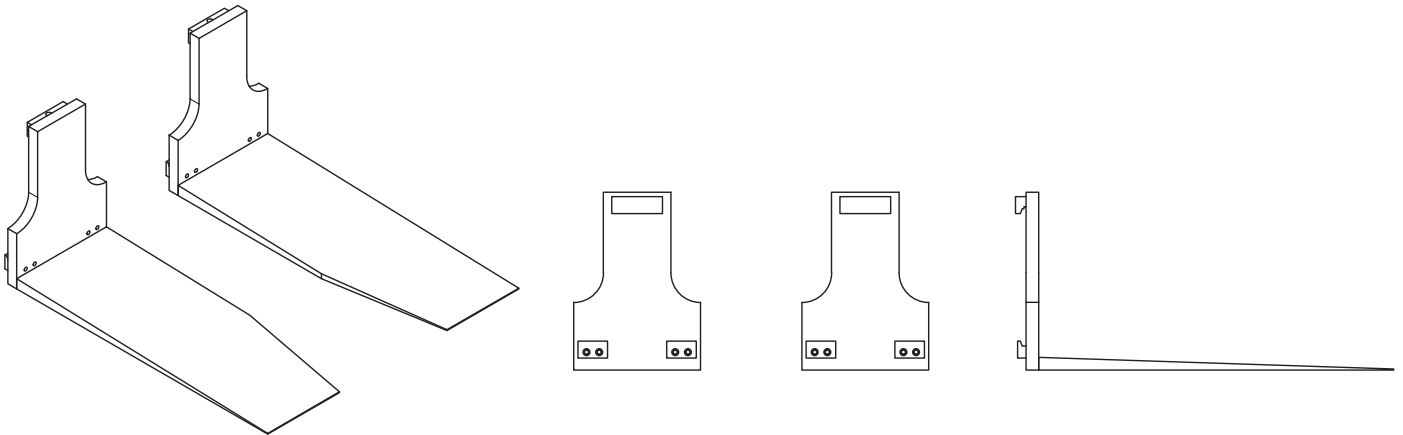

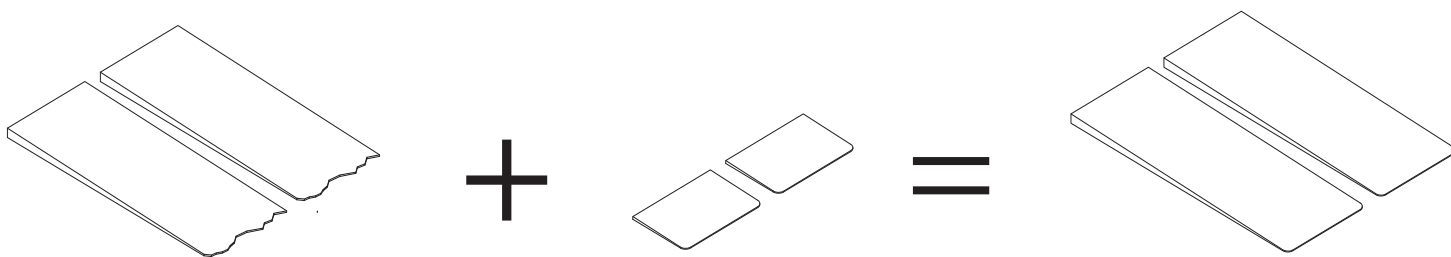

## PLATEN REPAIR TIPS



### OVERVIEW

Unfortunately, platens almost never last as long as the push pull they were designed for. Both normal use, and abuse causes the platens to wear short or chip. Not only does this reduce the effectiveness of the platens, but operating costs rise due to damaged slip sheets, or damaged product. Get your platens back in shape with our platen repair tips.

### ORDERING AND SIZING

#### To get dimensions for repair tips:

Find the point where the existing platens are 1/2" thick. Measure from that point to the overall desired platen length, this is your repair length.

Measure the width of the platen, this is your repair width.

Part numbers are formed on a case by case basis as follows:  
Part # PRT-XXWXXL

Example: your original platen was 15" wide, and 48" long, it has lost a few inches to damage and abuse. You want to repair the platen back to its original state. Your platen is 15.5 inches from where it is 1/2" thick to 48" from the face.

Your repair tip part number is "PRT-15W15.5L"
